SUBJECT: REVISED 2011-2012 SCHOOL PERFORMANCE GRADES

Late Friday, July 20, 2012, Commissioner of Education Gerard Robinson released a statement indicating that an error had occurred in the calculation of School Performance Grades for a number of districts statewide, including Miami-Dade. It has been reported that the initial release of School Performance Grades included a miscalculation of student learning gains. Based on the corrected calculations by the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE), 31 Miami-Dade County public schools, including 26 District schools and 5 charter schools, saw an increase in their Performance Grade. Highlights include:

- 13 schools improved from "B" to "A"; 9 schools improved from "C" to "B"; seven schools improved from "D" to "C"; and two schools improved from "F" to "D";
- With the increase in school performance grades for 31 schools, 89 percent of the schools in the District have received a School Performance Grade of C or better; and
- Forty-nine (49) percent of schools have attained a School Performance Grade of "A" for 2012.
