*The EOC Assessments are computer-based tests (CBT) that are given in one 160-minute session with a 10-minute break after the first 80 minutes. Students may be dismissed after the first 80 minutes as they complete testing. Any student not finished by the end of the 160 minutes may continue working; however, testing must be completed within one school day.

All paper accommodations (for students with documented accommodations only) must be administered on the first three days of the testing window.

The computer-based tests may be administered in any order by opened summer sites, based on needs of students within the school. One subject does not need to be completed before another begins, and tests for different subjects may be administered concurrently. Additionally, testing should be completed within the least number of days possible but <u>must</u> be completed by the last date noted above.

Important Note for M-DCPS opened adult education sites: The students taking the summer Algebra 1 course through adult education will take the Algebra 1 EOC test on July 22 and 23, with make-up testing on July 24 (see Weekly Briefing #15661 and Weekly Briefing #15777). Testing on these selected days will be scheduled from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Testing on other days and for other subjects must be carried out during the regular summer school hours, Monday through Thursday, 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m, using available resources.
