## Notes:

The FSA EOCs are delivered via the FSA Secure Browser, a computer-based test (CBT) platform. The FSA CBT tests may be scheduled based on student enrollment and technology resources. Paper-Based versions are provided for students with disabilities who require allowable accommodations, as specified in their individual educational plans (IEPs) or Section 504 plans.

\*The testing window in Miami-Dade County runs from September 12 through September 23, 2016. The EOC CBT tests may be administered in any order, by school, based on needs of students within a school. One subject does not need to be completed before another begins, and subject tests may be administered concurrently. CBT testing should be completed within the least number of days possible but must be completed by the last day of the testing window. All paper-based accommodations must be administered on Days 1 thru 4 of the test administration window, September 12-15, 2016.

Any deviation from this schedule requires written approval from the FLDOE prior to implementation.

<sup>\*\*</sup> FSA EOCs are administered in two 90-minute sessions, one session per day, over two days. Any student not finished by the end of each 90-minute session may continue working through half the length of a typical school day.
