- \* The FSA ELA in Grades 6-8 are administered in two 85-minute sessions, over two days. The FSA Mathematics in Grades 6-8 are administered in three 60 minute sessions over 2 days. Testing may begin on April 13 but must be completed by May 8. The FSA English/Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics (Grades 6-8) are delivered via a computer-based test (CBT) platform (FSA Secure Browser). The CBT tests may be scheduled based on student enrollment and technology resources. CBT tests may be administered starting on the first day of the testing window, but must be completed by the last day of the testing window, May 8. Paper-based versions are provided for students with disabilities who require allowable accommodations, as specified in their individual educational plans (IEPs) or Section 504 plans. Paper-based accommodations must be administered at the beginning of the test administration window, April 13-24.
- \*\*The FCAT 2.0 Science (Grade 8 only) is a paper-based administration. Science must be administered on the scheduled days with make-up administrations scheduled to April 24, as needed. Grade 8 FCAT 2.0 Science will be administered in two 80-minute sessions including a break in the middle of each session and both sessions are administered on the same day.

Note: Any deviation from this schedule requires written approval from the FLDOE prior to implementation.
