\*\*\*The following students in all schools must participate in progress monitoring, as specified in the calendar:

- Grades K-8: i-Ready, all students
  - For middle school students enrolled in Algebra 1 and Geometry,
    - AP1 required for students in Tier 2 and 3 schools and **optional** for students Tier 1 and Tier 1 WATCH schools
    - AP2 optional (not recommended) for all students
- Grades 9-10: FAIR, Levels 1 and 2.

\*\*\*\* Only includes ESE students exempted from standardized testing at these grade levels.

\*\*\*\*\* ELA only required for:

- students in Reading grades K-2,
- students with FSA ELA Levels 1 and 2 in grades 3-8
- grade 3 students scoring below 40<sup>th</sup> percentile in grade 2 SAT-10 Reading portion
- ASRA administered as i-Ready or ITBS for grade 3 students, needed as a promotion opportunity
