Description

In accordance with Florida Statute 1000.03, Governor DeSantis has directed the implementation of a new civic literacy requirement for high school students. Section 1007.25(4), Florida Statutes requires all students who enter a Florida college/university to meet a Civics Literacy Requirement. As such, MDCPS will conduct a pilot administration from April 20-24, 2020.

The pilot test will comprise of two sessions of 50 minutes each and will be administered over two days.

Results

A student must score 60% or higher on the Florida Civic Literacy Test to meet this postsecondary requirement,

A pending State Board of Education rule calls for colleges to accept students' passing scores from this pilot administration of the Florida Civic Literacy Test during the 2019-2020 school year.

Delivery

The test will be delivered on the Performance Matters testing platform as a computer-based assessment only.

No paper-based accommodated versions will be available for the pilot administration.
