

Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE)

Grades/Students

Students in Grades 9-12 who are enrolled in an AS or A Level Cambridge course OR those students who pay and register with the Cambridge Exams Officer at their school.

Date

The assessments are administered in May - June of each school year.

Description

Cambridge International AS and A Level examinations are standardized tests each with their examination criteria. These exams measure competence in high school students who have enrolled in one or more of the 60 subject courses. The AS and A Level Courses are equivalent to first-year college courses. Colleges or universities may give students advanced placement and/or credit for college-level studies.

Results

A five-point scale using letter grades ranging from Level A (highest) to Level E (lowest) is used in scoring AICE Exams. Participating colleges may award college credit for scores of E or higher. Results are provided to the District by CIE mid-August.
