

Advanced Placement Examinations (AP Exams)

Grades/Students

Students in grades 9-12 who register to take the test.

Date

Administered in May of each school year.

Description

AP examinations are standardized, criterion referenced tests. The 37 AP Exams measure competence in high school across 22 subject areas that are equivalent to first-year college courses. Colleges or universities may give students advanced placement and/or credit for college-level studies.

Results

A five-point scale is used in scoring AP Exams ranging from Level 1 (lowest) to Level 5 (highest). Participating colleges may award college credit for scores of 3 or higher. The results are returned from one month to six weeks after the test administration.
