High School Competency Test (HSCT)

Grades

Selected grade 13 and adult education students.

Date

Administered in October, January, March, and July of each year.

Description

The HSCT is a <u>standardized</u>, <u>criterion referenced</u> test. It is an untimed, <u>multiple choice</u> test with two subtests: Communications (reading and writing) and Mathematics. It measures the application of basic skills to everyday life situations. Selected students are still eligible to take and pass the HSCT to earn a standard diploma from public schools in Florida.

Results

Scale scores ranging from approximately 550 to 810 are provided. Students must obtain a <u>scale score</u> of 700 in each subtest in order to pass. Scores are returned approximately one month after each test administration.
