

## Interim Assessment (IA)

### Grades/Students

- In English Language Arts, all students in grades 3-11.
- In Mathematics, all students in grades 3 - 8 and those enrolled in Algebra 1 (**course codes: 1200310, 1200320, 1200380, 1209810, and 1200390**) Geometry (**course codes: 1206310, 1206320, 1206810, and 1209820**), and Algebra 2.
- In Science, all students in grades 5 and 8, and those enrolled in Biology 1 (**course codes: 2000310, 2000320, 2000322, 2000430, 2000800, 2000850, 2002440, and 2002450**)
- In Civics, all students enrolled in course codes: (**2106010, 2106015, 2106016, 2106020, 2106025, 2106026, 2106027, 2106028, 2106029, and 2100045**)
- In United States History, all students enrolled in course codes: (**2100310, 2100320, 2100390, and 2100480**)

### Date

Administered in the Fall and Winter of each school year.

### Description

The Interim Assessment tests are low stakes assessments that are administered for the purpose of targeting instruction on Florida Standards and the Next Generation Sunshine State Standards, The tests are administered in English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Civics, and United States History and are used to monitor ongoing progress of students.

### Results

Tests in English Language Arts, mathematics, science, and social studies are scored at each school-site using Thinkgate, the District's computerized management system. Reports may be generated at the student, classroom, school, and district level.

### Basis of Test

District tests to be administered in all schools for instructional purposes, progress reporting, or as a measure for the School Improvement Plans.
