

Oral Language Proficiency Scale – Revised (OLPS-R)

Grades/Students

All limited English proficient (LEP) students in grades K-12.

Date

Administered at time of entry to potential LEP students new to the District.
Administered in May of each school year.

Description

Miami-Dade County Oral Language Proficiency Scale – Revised Interview with Guidelines is a screening tool that is administered to LEP students to determine student's oral language proficiency.

Results

Results are immediately available to teachers/schools and are used for three purposes: (1) screening/initial placement of students into the ESOL program, (2) updating student's ESOL Level at the end of the year, and (3) exiting students from the program.
