

Preliminary ACT Test (PLAN)

Grade/Students

Interested students in Grade 10.

Date

The assessment is administered in September/October of each school year.

Description

The PLAN is a curriculum-based test that covers skills and knowledge commonly taught in the nation's schools. This timed test consists of four subtests: English, Mathematics, Reading, and Science. The test measures what students know and what they do with their knowledge.

Results

For each subtest, a score ranging from 1 (lowest) to 32 (highest) is provided. In addition, a composite score (average of individual subtest scores), ranging from 1 to 32 is provided six to eight weeks after the administration. National percentile ranks are provided so the students may compare their performance with other students in their grade level. Results also provide feedback for career development and transition to college.
