The assessment is administered during three assessment periods in September, January and April/May.

Description

The Florida Voluntary Prekindergarten Assessment is made up of four measures: Print Knowledge, Phonological Awareness, Mathematics, and Oral Language/Vocabulary. The purpose of the Florida Voluntary Prekindergarten Assessment is to provide teachers with valid and reliable feedback regarding students' progress in attaining the skills in the *Florida Early Learning and Developmental Standards for Four-Year-Olds (FELDS)*. Teachers use this information to guide instructional decisions in the VPK classroom.

Results

The VPK Assessment Online Reporting System will provide teachers with a user friendly tool to track children's progress on the FELDS. Students' results are immediately available online.
