STATE RELEASE OF RESULTS FOR THE SPRING 2009 FLORIDA COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENT TEST (FCAT) SUNSHINE STATE STANDARDS

(SSS) READING, MATHEMATICS, AND SCIENCE FOR GRADES 3-11

Today, the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) released results from the Spring 2009 administration of the Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test (FCAT) Sunshine State Standards (SSS) Reading, Mathematics, and Science assessments. Specifically, District and School summary reports were provided for students in Grades 4 through 10 in reading and mathematics, and for students in Grades 5, 8, and 11 in science. Although the FCAT SSS scores for students in Grade 3 were released previously to facilitate promotion decisions, they are included in this memorandum to provide a comprehensive summary of District results. It should be noted that these summary scores include all students tested and do not represent the groupings that will be used by the State for accountability purposes.

Overall, more than 206,000 students in the Miami-Dade County Public Schools (M-DCPS) participated in the Spring 2009 FCAT administration. The M-DCPS students' Reading and Mathematics scores improved from 2008 to 2009 at most grade levels, with growth also seen in elementary Science scores. In addition, record numbers of tenth grade students passed the Reading and Mathematics graduation tests on their first attempt. Further, achievement improved substantially in both reading and math for students in three M-DCPS schools (Liberty City Elementary, Holmes Elementary, and Miami Central Senior High), identified for intensive District intervention as part of the State's Differentiated Accountability system. Highlights of the M-DCPS students' results and summary tables providing comparisons of State and District results by grade level are provided as attachments to this memorandum.

Additional reports of District and school trends, as well as disaggregated reports by curriculum group and demographic characteristics, will be transmitted to the Board and posted online as they become available. Highlights of the Florida Department of Education's Spring 2009 Summary Report for Miami-Dade County Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test (FCAT) Sunshine State Standards (SSS) Grades 3 through 11

OVERALL

- Improvement in all three subject areas (reading, mathematics, and science) was seen for District elementary school students in grades 4 and 5, with sizeable increases in the percentage of students scoring in Levels 3 - 5.
 - o The percentage of the District's students in grade 3 scoring in Levels 3 − 5 in mathematics increased from 2008 to 2009, but declined slightly in reading.
- The performance of District middle school students was mixed, with marked improvement in the percentage of students in grade 6 scoring high from 2008 to 2009 in both reading and mathematics; less consistent results were evident in grades 7 and 8.
- Overall, the FCAT Reading and Mathematics results for the District's senior high school students improved substantially from 2008 to 2009, outpacing state gains in the percentages of ninth and tenth grade students scoring high (Levels 3 - 5).

READING

- District students' mean Scale Scores and Developmental Scale Scores improved in reading in all grades 4 through 10 from 2008 to 2009.
- Fifty-one percent of the District's tenth grade students passed the FCAT Reading graduation test on their first attempt in March 2009, exceeding 50% for the first time and closing in on the overall percentage of the students passing statewide.

MATHEMATICS

- District students' mean Scale Scores and Developmental Scale Scores improved in mathematics in all but grades 7 and 8 from 2008 to 2009.
- Seventy-eight percent of the District's tenth grade students passed the FCAT Mathematics graduation test on their first attempt in March 2009, closing the gap in the overall percentage of the students passing statewide.

SCIENCE

• Mean Scale Scores improved in science for District students in grade 5 from 2008 to 2009; the scores declined slightly for students in grades 8 and 11.

MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS Summary of District and State Results for the Spring 2009 Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test (FCAT) Sunshine State Standards (SSS) Grades 3 through 11

On May 28, 2009, the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) released data from the Spring 2009 administration of the Florida Comprehensive Assessment Test (FCAT) Sunshine State Standards (SSS) Reading, Mathematics, and Science assessments. The tables that follow provide summaries of the data for students in Grades 3 through 10 in reading and mathematics, and for students in Grades 5, 8, and 11 in science.

The FCAT SSS is a criterion-referenced test, which measures students' mastery of grade level content as specified by the Sunshine State Standards. Results are reported in terms of achievement levels which can range from Level 1 (low) to Level 5 (high); Scale Scores, which can range from 100 – 500 at each grade level; and Developmental Scale Scores, which represent a continuous scale across all grade levels and can range from 0 to 3000. Note that the summary results presented are based on all students tested, including students with disabilities (SWD) and English Language Learners (ELL), and do not represent the groupings that will be used by the State for accountability purposes.

Section I: Reading, Mathematics, and Science

The following tables provide a view of student performance across three years: 2007, 2008, and 2009. Detailed results showing the percentage of students scoring in Levels 1, 2, and 3-5 for the District and State by grade level are provided for reading, mathematics, and science in Tables 1, 2, and 3 respectively.

Also presented is a summary of student performance in terms of the more precise Scale Scores (SS) that underlie the performance levels of the FCAT SSS Reading, Mathematics, and Science assessments. In addition, Developmental Scale Scores (DSS) in reading and mathematics represent a continuous scale across grade levels that may be used to track growth in achievement as students progress from Grade 3 through Grade 10. District mean SS and DSS are presented in Tables 4 and 5 for reading and mathematics and in Table 6 for science. Tables 4 and 5 are accompanied by a graphic representation of the mean DSS in 2007, 2008, and 2009.




Figure 1. Mean Developmental Scale Scores on FCAT Reading for Miami-Dade County Public School students in 2007, 2008, and 2009.




Figure 2. Mean Developmental Scale Scores on FCAT Mathematics for Miami-Dade County Public School students in 2007, 2008, and 2009.

Section II: GRADE 10 FCAT SSS GRADUATION TEST PASSING RATES

High school students must pass FCAT Reading and Mathematics tests to meet Florida's testing requirement for a standard diploma. Students have multiple opportunities to do so prior to graduation. The first FCAT administration that can be used to satisfy the graduation requirement takes place in the spring of tenth grade, as part of the standard FCAT SSS assessment program. In Spring 2009, 24,805 Grade 10 students took the FCAT SSS Reading test and 24,700 took the FCAT SSS Mathematics test. These are duplicated counts, as the majority of the students took both tests.

FCAT scale scores can range from 100 to 500, and students must attain passing scores of 300 on both the Reading and the Mathematics tests to graduate with a standard diploma. The passing rate information provided below is for first-time test takers and does not include retained Grade 10 students who took the FCAT Retake format of the test.
