# MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS Summary of District, State and National Results for the ACT Assessment Graduating Class of 2010

On August 18, 2010, ACT, Inc. released District, state, and national results from students in the 2010 graduating class who chose to participate in the ACT Assessment. This report provides information for the 2010 graduating seniors who took the ACT as sophomores, juniors, and/or seniors and who reported at the time of testing that they were scheduled to graduate in 2010 and tested under standard time conditions. Test records for students who tested under extended time conditions are not included. The ACT is a curriculum-based measure of college readiness which includes subtests in English, Mathematics, Reading, and Science. ACT scores can range from a low of 1 to a high of 36.

The 2010 ACT mean scores for the English, Mathematics, Reading, and Science test sections, as well as the overall Composite scores, are presented in Table 1 for the District, the state, and the nation. For students who took the test more than once, only the most recent test scores are included in the analysis. Individual school ACT results for the Class of 2010 are presented in Table 2. This table displays the number of test-takers at each school, as well as the mean scores for each subject area test and the accompanying Composite score. School summary score results are not presented if fewer than 10 students participated; however, the data for these schools are included in the District and state results.

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#### Highlights of the ACT Assessment Results Summary Report for Miami-Dade County Graduating Class of 2010

#### M-DCPS Results

- Both the average Reading and Mathematics ACT scores of the graduating class of 2010 were higher than the concordant scores required to meet high school graduation requirements.
- Almost twice as many graduating seniors of 2010 participated in the ACT than their counterparts in 2006.
  - In 2010, 55% (12,686) of the graduating seniors took the ACT, up from 49% (11,513) in the class of 2009, 43% (9762) in 2008, 37% (8235) in 2007, and only 30% (6417) in 2006.
- At District level, the mean ACT scores decreased slightly from 2009 to 2010 in all content areas except Science, which remained stable. At both the national and District levels, the mean ACT English and Reading scores decreased slightly from 2009 to 2010.

#### Individual School Results

- Graduating seniors from 71 M-DCPS schools participated in the ACT.
- In Reading, 24%, or 15 of the 63 high schools with ten or more participating students had ACT scores at or above the state mean, and 19%, or 12 schools, had scores at or above the national mean.
- In Mathematics, 22%, or 14 of the 63 high schools with ten or more participating students had ACT scores at or above the state mean, and 17%, or 11 schools, had scores at or above the national mean.
